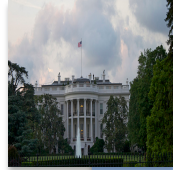


Separation of Power- The Three Branches of Government



Legislative Branch

- Congress
 - Senate
 - House of Representatives
- Makes Laws
- Taxes people
- Declares war
- Can override presidential veto
- Approves presidential appointments



Executive Branch

- President is Head
- President is commander-in-chief of armed forces
- President deals with other countries
- President may veto bills passed by Congress



Judicial Branch

- Interpret the law - decides if laws are constitutional
- Supreme court highest court
- Judges are appointed by the President
- 9 Judges
